**FULL TIME NATIONAL GUARD DUTY-COUNTERDRUG (FTNGD-CD) #15-002
TITLE 32 USC SEC 502 (f)**

POSITION: Counterdrug Task Force Operations Officer, Coventry, Rhode Island (2 Positions)

GRADE: O-2 or below (Also see Area of Consideration below).

AFSC/MOS: **Immaterial**

SALARY: Full military pay and allowances, depending upon military grade and longevity of the applicant selected.

CLOSING DATE: 20 March 2015 with interviews being schedule on the 26th to 27th of March 2015

AREA OF CONSIDERATION: Open to currently assigned Service Members, O-1 to O-2 in the Army National Guard (Also see Eligibility Requirements below).

MILITARY ASSIGNMENT: Selected applicants will remain assigned militarily to their current M-Day duty assignment.

ELIGIBILITY REQUIREMENTS: Selected applicants must:

- a. Be a member of the Rhode Island Army Guard.
- b. Meet height, weight and physical fitness requirements without permanent or temporary profiles
- c. Not be flagged for personnel actions.
- d. Also see Area of Consideration requirements above.
- e. Be eligible for FTNGD-CD in accordance with normal NG requirements per CNGBI 3100.01, National Guard Counterdrug Support.
- f. Be recommended by your commander.
- g. Obtain favorable interview with Counterdrug Coordinator (CDC) or representative.
- h. Possess favorable Entrance National Agency Check/ National Agency Check (ENTNAC/NAC) within past 15 years (**secret** security clearance is required).
- i. Obtain favorable interview and/or investigation/security check by Law Enforcement Agency (LEA) or Community Based Organization (CBO) (if required by the specific LEA/CBO concerned). Rejection by LEA or CBO could result in removal from the CD program.
- j. Favorable urinalysis testing is required upon entry on active duty, and personnel are subject to periodic testing while on active duty. These requirements are in addition to testing by units of assignment during IDT/IAD under the JNGSAP.
- k. Required to continue attendance at IDT/IAD and AT while on FTNGD-CD.
- l. ARNG Personnel must meet medical retention standards as set forth in AR 40-501 Chapter 3 and Chapter 10. ANG personnel must meet the medical retention standards as set forth in AFI 48-123 Chapter 3 and Attachments 2, 9, and 19. ARNG/ANG personnel who serve on CD duty for 31 or more consecutive days are subject thereafter to retention standards of AR 40-501 or AFI 48-123 while they remain on duty.
- m. Army National Guard personnel must meet the HIV testing requirements of AR 600-110 (Identification, Surveillance and Administration of Personnel Infected with Human Immunodeficiency Virus (HIV)).
- n. Funding for the Counterdrug Program is subject to annual appropriated funding levels, and reductions in staff or breaks in duty could be required in the event of reduced budgets.
- p. Special Requirements: No prior drug positives.

q. National Guard members participating in the Counterdrug Support Program are required to comply with state laws and with DoD 5500.7-R. They are required to uphold the highest standards of conduct and personal appearance.

r. Outside employment, associations and off-duty conduct/activities must be consistent with federal directives on ethics and with state and federal conflict of interest policies. Outside employment will require written approval of CDC.

LENGTH OF TOUR: The selected individual will be placed on FTNGD-CD from 15 Apr 15 – 30 Sep 15.

DUTIES AND RESPONSIBILITIES: See attached position description for the Counterdrug Operations' Officer position.

HOW TO APPLY: Applicants, as a minimum will submit

-Entrance National Agency Check/ National Agency Check (ENTNAC/NAC) within past 10 years

- ARNG Format 1058-R, Application for Active Duty for Training, July 02 attached (Signed by soldier, records custodian and unit commander)

(Air) If reaching sanctuary, signed sanctuary waiver IAW AFI 36-2131

-Recommendation from Unit Commander (template attached)

-Resume/Military Biographical Brief

-(Army) Medical Protection System (MEDPROS)-Individual Medical readiness (IMR) Record. (Air) Individual Medical Readiness from AF Portal under the Medical Readiness link.

-Female applicants must submit a pregnancy test showing NEGATIVE results within fifteen days of start of orders. A POSITIVE test will result in termination from orders.

- (Army) APFT Card DA 705 (current within 6 months). and DA 55000/5501 if Applicable (Air) Fitness test printout from AF Portal.

- (Army) Current Retirement points Accounting System (RPAS) (Air) Retirement Points Summary from vMPF.

- DD Form 369 Police Record Check ((Section I) 2, 3, 4, 5, 6, 7, 8, 9 (Section II))

-Signed Special Requirements for Counterdrug Duty Form (attached)

Submissions must reach the NGRI-OPN-CD office **NO LATER THAN THE CLOSING DATE.** Applications received after the closing date will NOT be considered. The use of government envelopes, postage or facsimile machines to submit applications is prohibited. NGRI-DCSOPS-CD may receive facsimiles sent from non-government facsimile machines.
