b. Complete the Out-Processing Checklist provided to me by my unit readiness/admin NCO.

3. I understand that I must make an appointment with the State Retirement Services Officer (RSO) at 401-275-4142 to sign my NGB Form 22 and receive my briefing/retirement packet.
