SUBJECT: Full-time National Guard Duty Qualifying for a Reduced Eligibility Age for Receipt of Non-regular Retired Pay in Calendar Year 2022

References: (a) DoD Instruction 1215.07, "Service Credit for Non-Regular Retirement," July 30, 2019

- (b) Proclamation 7463, "Declaration of National Emergency by Reason of Certain Terrorist Attacks," September 14, 2001
- (c) Proclamation 9994, "Declaring a National Emergency Concerning the Novel Coronavirus Disease (COVID-19) Outbreak," March 13, 2020

Pursuant to paragraph 3.5.e. of reference (a), I have determined that full-time National Guard duty (FTNGD) performed in a section 502, subsection (f) of title 32, United States Code (U.S.C.), duty status at the national security special events (NSSEs) listed below was for the purpose of deterring or responding to acts of terrorism in response to the national emergency declared in reference (b). Such FTNGD, therefore, satisfies the requirements of subsection (f)(2)(B)(ii) of section 12731 of title 10, U.S.C. Accordingly, I designate any such FTNGD as qualifying service for the purpose of reducing the eligibility age for receipt of non-regular retired pay under section 12731. The qualifying NSSEs are:

Additionally, I have determined that FTNGD performed in a section 502 duty status in response to the national emergency declared in reference (c) satisfies the requirements of section 12731. Accordingly, I designate any such FTNGD as qualifying service for the purpose of reducing the eligibility age for receipt of non-regular retired pay under section 12731.
