

Commander's Briefing (IR/IU Test Basis)

Today our unit will be drug tested for illegal substance use. The primary purpose of this test is to ensure our unit's military fitness and that we maintain proper standards of readiness.

In accordance with AR 600-85, Soldiers in this unit are selected for either an Inspection Random (IR) drug test or Inspection Unit (IU), also known as a unit sweep. There is no probable cause or reasonable suspicion that anyone in the unit is misusing controlled substances.

Everyone selected will be tested. Anyone not present will be rescheduled for testing at a later date.

Every specimen collected will be tested for Marijuana Delta-9 (THC); Delta-8 (THC); Cocaine; Amphetamines (which include methamphetamines, MDMA (ecstasy), and MDA); heroin; opiates (which include, morphine and codeine); synthetic opioids (Oxycodone/ oxymorphone) commonly known as OxyCotin and Hydrocodone/ hydromorphone; Fentanyl; selected benzodiazepines; and synthetic cannabinoids, commonly known as Spice. Lysergic Acid Diethylamide (LSD) has been added on a rotational basis.

Note: Every specimen collected will be tested for all routine substances currently listed on the DoD-authorized panel of drugs and any rotational drugs.

Testing procedures outlined in AR 600-85 will be followed in addition to current drug testing policy.

All Soldiers must be aware that all verbal orders connected with this drug testing are lawful and are to be followed.

Refusal to comply with orders relating to this test will subject the Soldier to punitive or administrative actions under AR 600-85, AR 135-178, AR 635-200, and AR 600-8-24.
