Purpose: This website allows beneficiaries to review personal, health care, and personnel information from one reliable source: DEERS. The following functions can be performed:

- eCorrespondence
 - View, print or save: TRICARE enrollment card, Dependent 21/23 letters, TRR/TRS information letters
 - Submit, view, print or save: DD Form 3175, DoD Civilian Employee Certification of Vaccination
- Health Care Information
 - View and update medical, pharmacy, dental information
- Education
 - Transfer Education Benefits to one or more family members

- Modify transfer requests that have already been submitted
- Service Members' Group Life Insurance(SGLI)
 - View and update coverage details for SGLI

Trusted Associate Sponsorship Program (TASS)

Site Visitors: Users of TASS (service points of contact or SPOCs, trusted agent security managers or TASMs, trusted agents or TAs, applicant (individual applying for a government credential or CAC)

Purpose: Application to apply for a government credential or CAC for specified populations or personnel categories

Login required: Yes; CAC only for SPOC, TASM, and TA roles and Applicant TASS-generated user ID and Password

Login types: PKI and user ID and password
