AREA OF CONSIDERATION

Current Majors (with less than 3 years' time in grade), Promotable Captains, Chief Warrant Officer Four (with less than 3 years' time in grade) and Promotable Chief Warrant Officer Three in the Rhode Island Army National Guard who meet all criteria listed in the qualification requirements below. Only open to eligible traditional M-Day or Technician Soldiers in the Rhode Island Army National Guard.

QUALIFICATION REQUIREMENTS

Must be capable and possess the leadership skills required of a Company Commander and Brigade Staff officer. Serve a minimum of 36 months; have a current Periodic Health Assessment (within 12 months); a passing Army Combat Fitness Test (within 12 months) and not be under a current suspension of favorable personnel actions or required to be under suspension (IAW AR 600-8-2), even if suspension has not been imposed.

OTHER REQUIREMENTS

Must be available to interview on a date and time to be determined at the Joint Force Headquarters. **Uniform is the Operational Camouflage Pattern Duty Uniform.** Soldiers will be contacted by phone for notification of date and time for the interview.

PRIMARY DUTIES AND RESPONSIBILITIES

Detachment Commander of the Joint Force Headquarters for the Rhode Island National Guard (RING). Responsible for the discipline, morale, welfare, and logistical support of 165 personnel assigned to the G-staff of a Division command. Leads and supervises the planning and execution of the unit level Annual Training, Unit Training, and Individual Training requirements. Provides training support to external commands.
