## SPECIAL FORCES (SF/18) OFFICER CAREER DEVELOPMENT MODEL

A Special Forces (SF) officer must first successfully serve in their basic branch to be eligible for SF. Upon graduation from the SFQC, the officer serves in a KD position as a SF CPT, followed by other developmental positions described below. SF CPTs should successfully command an SFOD-A, minimally for 24 months. SF MAJs require a Master's degree and will be prioritized for assignment to an 18A coded billet. Officers in this grade should successfully serve for a minimum of 24 months in any of the KD positions listed below or a combination of these position. Promotion to LTC constitutes success, and subsequent assignments focus on developing the officer for broader contributions to the branch, the Army, and special operations in general. Key developmental assignments for a SF LTC include successful service as a SF tactical, SF training, or Immaterial battalion commander. SF COLs continue to serve the branch, special operations, and the Army through service in any SF-coded Colonel position or combination of positions within the key organizations listed below.
